- * I understand I am responsible for the payment of my pullets.
- *Pullets are expected to arrive in late March or early April (varies based on hatching time), and it is my responsibility to pick the pullets up before 5:00p.m. on designated day from **The Ed**Jones Agri-Plex Auditorium, 1252 Manufacturers Row, in Trenton.
- * I am responsible for providing a "take-home" container for my chicks. (Rubbermaid tote, cardboard box, etc.)
- * I agree to enter my top three (3) pullets in the 4-H Chick Chain Show in August.
- *I agree to complete the **4-H Poultry Record Book**, which will be due at the C. C. Show.
- * I understand that housing, feed, and care of my pullets is my responsibility.
- * I understand the Gibson County 4-H is not liable for any deaths or injuries to my pullets after they leave the 4-H office.
- * The pullets are mine to keep or sell at my own discretions.
- * I understand that all applications and monies are due by February 17th to the Gibson County Extension Office, and not my school.
